

VALLEY OF THE MOON VINTAGE FESTIVAL ART BOOTH RULES & REGULATIONS

The following applicant hereby applies for a booth space in connection with The Valley of the Moon Vintage Festival to be held in the Sonoma Plaza on the last full weekend of September each year.

Applicant hereby agrees to the following terms and conditions for acceptance and participation in the Festival:

1. Applicant must display and sell only original works of art. No kits.
2. Applicant will obtain the appropriate Business License for the City of Sonoma prior to submitting VOMVF Application.
3. Applicant will comply with all City of Sonoma and Sonoma County Fire Department regulations.
4. Applicant will comply with City of Sonoma Ordinance 432 (regulations governing parks). A copy is available for review at City Hall.
5. All vehicles utilized by Applicant in connection with Festival activities must be insured for liability in accordance with the State of California minimum requirements.
6. THERE WILL BE NO PERMITS ISSUED FOR PARKING ON THE PLAZA BEHIND CITY HALL OR IN THE HORSESHOE AREA DURING THE FESTIVAL: THIS INCLUDES VEHICLES FOR THE DISABLED. There are multiple areas around the Plaza for disabled vehicle parking.
7. THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING ON SIDEWALKS OR LAWNS, EVEN TO SET UP OR TO TEAR DOWN, per ruling of the Sonoma Police Department and Parks and Recreation Department.
8. Applicant will NOT hold VOMVF accountable for any theft or damage of merchandise or property throughout the weekend event
9. Applicant will erect their booth in its proper location per map that you will receive. The area in the Plaza will be marked for you on Friday. Note that there is no Friday night setup allowed.
10. Booths must be set back 6 feet from the sidewalks. No exceptions.
11. Applicant will comply with directions of the Festival and the City of Sonoma officials with regard to specifying which electrical outlets Applicant may use for power.
12. Applicant will keep the booth area clean and free of litter during the Festival. The booth area is defined as running to the middle of the sidewalk in front and an equal distance to the rear and to the adjoining booth on the sides.
13. Each Applicant is responsible for the security of their booth during the Festival. The Festival assumes no liability for lost, damaged or stolen items during the duration of the Festival or during set up and tear down.

14. Applicant will completely dismantle and remove their booth and clean up their area no later than 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.
15. No amplified sound of any type will be allowed in connection with any booth.
16. Nothing may be attached to the trees in the plaza.
17. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that the Festival reserves the right to disapprove any application for any activity, the purpose of which, in the sole opinion of the Board of Directors, is not in harmony with the purpose of the Vintage Festival.
18. Applicant acknowledges that they carry the requisite business liability insurance. Applicant agrees to name the Festival as an "Additional Insured" on applicant's policy and hereby agrees to release the Festival of all financial responsibility or liability for any personal injury due to the fault of applicant.
19. NO T-SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, POSTERS, CAPS, APRONS, BAGS, GLASSES, or WATER may be sold or offered as prizes except by the Festival Booth and authorized vendors.
20. All garbage must be placed in trash receptacles. Any garbage left on the Festival grounds by applicant will result in forfeiture of your clean up deposit.
21. In the event of rain no fees will be refunded. The Festival goes on rain or shine!
22. Notification of intent to withdraw a booth from the Festival by applicant must be received in writing by August 31, 2016 by the Festival. If notification is not received by the date mentioned herein all monies, except for the clean up/accounting deposit, shall be retained by the Festival.
23. Any vendor found selling products not stated on application will be asked to vacate the premises immediately without a refund of fees.
24. Submission of application signifies acceptance of the above stated Rules & Regulations.
